a financial donation. We would be grateful to receive them as we want to furnish these units for individuals who will be renting them.

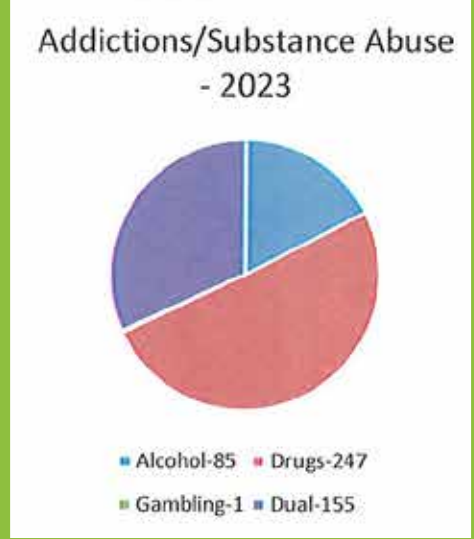
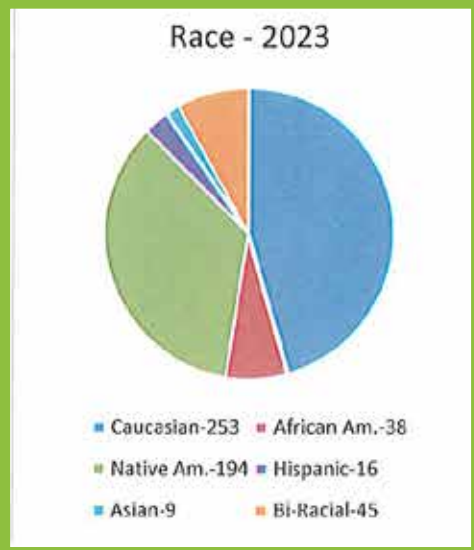
January Water Pipe Break Did Not Displace Our Guests!



In January, a fire suppression pipe busted causing water to flood the second floor of the south wing and then flooding the main south floor. Our guests and staff worked alongside our amazing Sioux Falls Fire Department to push water into the drains to save the flooring, so our female guests were not displaced. Intek came immediately alongside Best Choice to bring fans and commercial dehumidifiers to get the sheetrock dry. Unfortunately, there was damage to both bathrooms and both offices and the exercise rooms were complete loses. The St. Francis House has amazing community partners who came to help us out such as CMIT to replace our computers, Telephone Systems & Service, Inc. got phones reprogrammed and Lloyd Companies gathered our subs to get the work scheduled to be completed. We are thankful to have everyone back in their areas working with no interruptions in services. 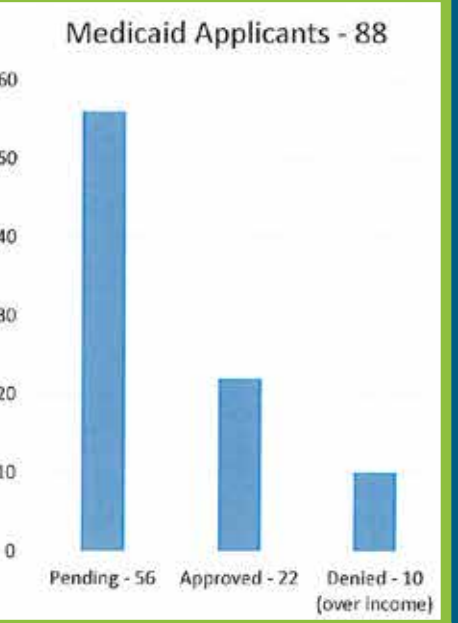

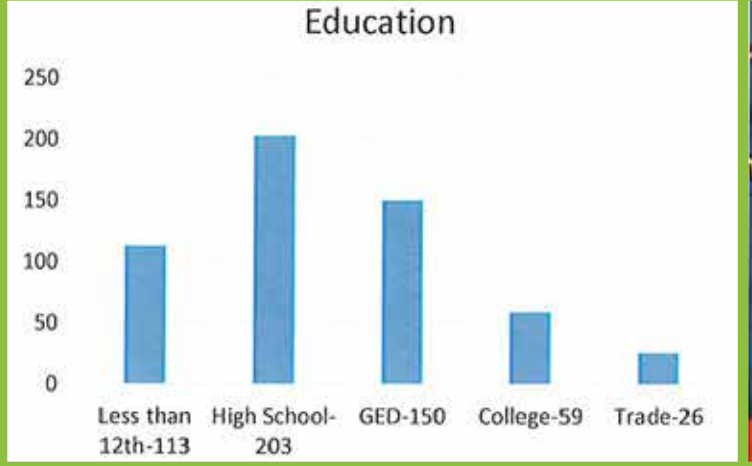
